A comparison of donations by branch of 2018 vs 2019 is shown below. Total giving increased by \$5,524. 53 from 2018 to 2019. Please note that the below numbers represent total giving to all National Funds including the fund to sponsor the Women of Distinction Ceremony.

As of Feb 28, 2020, we still needed to raise \$8,042 to complete the \$20,000 funding needed to be a Platinum Sponsor for the 2020 event.
