BYLAWS COMMITTEE REPORT
March 26, 2022

At the 2021 annual convention, the Bylaws Committee presented proposed changes to the state bylaws. Those changes were approved by the delegates, and it appeared that the committee's work was done.

However, last summer the newly updated bylaws were reviewed by a member of the AAUW Board who has experience in the subject. She identified a few bylaws that needed to be reworded and the committee has done that.

The committee presents five bylaw changes for approval at the annual meeting this year. Each one either clarifies the intent of a bylaw or specifies the scope of the Executive Board's responsibilities.

In addition to working on the bylaws, the committee has revised the AAUW Maryland Handbook, a compilation of documents to guide state officers in their roles. The work is nearly finished, and the Handbook will be made available to all state officers later this year.
