Purpose:

To be responsible for planning and developing mutual support between educational institutions and AAUW MD and assist branches to do the same.

To encourage recruitment of educational institutions in Maryland

Responsibilities:

Chair the College/University Committee which may include the representatives of the college/university members in Maryland.

Participate in establishing state priorities for action.

Advise state public policy committee of legislation affecting higher education and recommend action.

Suggest research and inquiry on issues relating to higher education, particularly as it concerns women.

Integrate state programs and projects involving college campuses.

Communicate with college/university representatives, branch presidents and other educational organizations within the state.

Promote cooperation between college/university members and branches on projects of mutual interest and concern.

Promote branch membership for college/university representatives and integration of issues on higher education within branch programs.

Facilitate efforts of local branches to recruit college faculty and staff to join AAUW

Facilitate efforts of local branch to recruit students to become student affiliates

Facilitate efforts to jointly sponsor projects with the branch that offer benefits to the campus

Share AAUW Outlook and other AAUW publications with appropriate college staff

Distribute information about AAUW educational foundation grants and fellowships
Distribute information about services that are available through the AAUW Legal Advocacy Fund

Act as a liaison to the branch to coordinate the use of college facilities for branch or statewide meetings

Be an active branch member

Serve as a liaison to coordinate the use of the campus library for AAUW research

Attend State and Association conventions whenever possible

Qualifications:

Knowledge of or interest in educational institutions in Maryland

Aware of needs and expertise of College/University representative in Maryland
